II. Sun, 3/14/25 – “The Right Perception Can Guide You to Fruitfulness”

A. *“And she said unto her husband, Behold now, I perceive that this is an holy man of God, which passeth by us continually” 2 Kings 4:9 (KJV).* The Shunammite woman saw Elisha often passing by, but it was only when she perceived who he really was, that he would become the answer to her barrenness. The goal of this lesson is to encourage the Believer to study the Word daily, so that the right perception can be developed, which is able to guide us to fruitfulness.

B. As seen from the Shunammite woman’s example in 2 Kings 4:8-9, how can the right perception guide a Believer to fruitfulness?

1. The right perception will guide you to recognize the anointing. How can this lead to fruitfulness? (Reference Scriptures: 1 Samuel 16:7 – David was not just an illegitimate boy, Genesis 39:2-6 – Joseph was not just a slave, and Genesis 41:39-40 – Joseph was not just a foreign prisoner

2. The right perception will guide you to partner with the anointing with a unique assignment, strategy, or plan. How can this lead to fruitfulness? (Reference Scriptures: 2 Kings 4:9-10, 2 Kings 5:10-14, and 2 Chronicles 20:15-30

3. The right perception will lead you into the right atmosphere that can deal with barrenness. How can this lead to fruitfulness? (Reference Scriptures: 2 Kings 4:11-17, Psalm 1:1-3, Proverbs 3:5-10, and John 15:5)

C. If having the right perception will guide a Believer to fruitfulness how can my perception be developed? (Reference Scriptures: Romans 12:2, Joshua 1:8, and Hebrews 5:14)

Closing Summary: *“She said to her husband, ‘I know that this man who often comes our way is a holy man of God’ 2 Kings 4:9 (NIV).* The Shunammite woman perceived Elisha to be a holy man of God and she allowed that right perception to guide her. Her right perception guided her to recognize the anointing. Her right perception guided her to partner with the anointing. Finally, her right perception guided her to the right atmosphere that provided the answer for her barrenness. The goal of this lesson was to encourage the Believer to study the Word daily, so they can develop the right perception, which is able to guide us to fruitfulness.
